Dear Congregant,

Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur are a few weeks away. Accordingly, we want to reiterate the policy that has guided our synagogue during this period and remind you of the option to reserve seats for the High Holidays.

### **ONLY MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING RECEIVE TICKETS AT NO CHARGE**

Your membership entitles you to receive High Holiday tickets for the adults and students (children 12 years and older) in your immediate household. Recently married children (less than one year) are also entitled to these tickets.

We ask members who have past due balances to contact the President or Treasurer to make payment arrangements.

### **Purchase High Holiday tickets for independent children and guests**

Members are required to purchase a ticket for each child who is independent and living away from home. You must also buy tickets for other guests such parents, relatives and friends. The cost for each ticket is:

- \$150 for both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur
- \$100 for one of the High Holidays -- Rosh Hashanah or Yom Kippur services

### **Option to reserve your High Holiday seats**

Members in good standing can select and reserve their seats for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur in advance of the holidays.

- The price of a reserved seat is \$100 for members and \$200 for each of their guests.
- If you reserved a seat last year, you must reserve and make the payment by September 8 to keep the same seat.
- All other seat reservations are on a first-come, first-serve basis. A reserved seat this year, entitles you to reserve the same seat next year.
- The reservation is valid for both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. The price of a reserved seat is not reduced if you are attending only one holiday SSTC
- A seating chart of the sanctuary is enclosed showing those seats already reserved. Payment for the seats you reserve must be received with your selection. Any seat not reserved and paid for by September 8 will be released to the congregation for new reservations or open seating.
- Seats in the sanctuary will be numbered. Your High Holiday tickets will be numbered and correspond to the seats you reserved.

### **One point of entry to and departure from the Synagogue**

The Synagogue's main doors on Mt. Pleasant Avenue will be the only way to enter and exit the building during the High Holidays. The doors in the rear of the building will be locked during this period. A security officer and volunteers from the congregation will be stationed at the Synagogue's entrance at Mt. Pleasant Avenue. Please present your ticket upon entering the Synagogue. The officer may inspect your bags or packages. The volunteer will check your name against a membership list if you misplaced or forgot your ticket. Please comply with these inspection procedures.

### **ACTION REQUIRED: Request High Holiday tickets before August 18, 2010**

1. Use the Ticket Request form to indicate the number of High Holiday tickets required.
2. To reserve seats, use the seating chart to select the seats you want to reserve.
